My chookar mere man ko experience in this trying Covid times, it was October, but then instead of enjoying festival, I had a sudden unending headache and fever.

I got myself tested and the result was positive. By then I had already isolated myself. I asked everyone in my family to get tested including my 77 year-old mom. We were shocked to know that all were positive. They didn't have any symptoms and thereafter began the quarantine period. But I had to get admitted to hospital.

The isolation ward was managed by very young energetic brave nurses clad in heavy PPE gears and kits which were very bothersome to them. Some of them are sweating underneath it but silently nursing all patients.

Now this very young, just joined nurse, was very tense and under stress, still working during the Pooja nights. She came to give me a drip. I saw her and felt she isn't feeling right. The next moment, before she could connect me to the drip, she fell bang on floor, unconscious.

The other nurses and staff scrambled in and took her away. Being Pooja there were limited staff, and there were no nurses to be seen.

After 1 hour or so, all of them returned to the ward. And to my utter surprise, I suddenly found the same nurse, completing the drip connection, from where she left, before being unconscious.
