AAPKA AANCHAL: WHEN COMMUNITIES RISE, EARTH HEALS

In the water-stressed landscapes of Munger and Begusarai located in Bihar, India, where fields long struggled against scarcity, Aapka Aanchal dared to reimagine what community action could achieve. What began as a mission to revive dying water sources soon grew into a movement of hope, resilience, and collective determination.

Facing the challenges of shrinking groundwater and declining agricultural productivity, the organisation mobilized local women, empowering them to lead change from the frontlines. Together, they dug over 1,500 water conservation pits, built perennial ponds, and undertook the laborious task of manually clearing invasive water hyacinth choking the Ganga distributaries.

Through these efforts, irrigation returned, organic farming flourished, and water security strengthened, restoring both livelihood and dignity to the communities they serve.

Electrosteel proudly honoured Aapka Aanchal, a symbol of grassroots leadership and a beacon of sustainable water stewardship, with the Jal Sevak Samman Award 2025.


