SPOTLIGHT ON WATER WARRIORS: JAL SEVAK SAMMAN 2025

The third edition of Electrosteel Jal Sevak Samman 2025 was held on 31st August. Individuals and institutions driving impactful change were honoured for their monumental efforts at safeguarding Earth's most vital resource. The award ceremony was graced by Hon'ble Justice Mr. K. G. Balakrishnan, Former Chief Justice of India & Chairperson, National Commission on Conversion, as the Chief Guest, Mr. P. M. Prasad, Chairman & Managing Director of Coal India, along with Dr. Dhriti Banerjee, Director of Zoological Survey of India, and Mr. Nelapatla Ashok Babu, Director, National Water Mission, Ministry of Jal Shakti, Government of India graced the event as the Special Guest.

The award was conferred in three categories to five personnel:

In the Individual Category, the Jal Sevak Samman 2025 was awarded to Ms. Lilabati Mahata from West Bengal for her tireless grassroots initiatives in Jhargram, which involved pond-based water and soil conservation to enhance irrigation, crop diversification, and farm incomes.

Mr. James Herenj from Jharkhand was recognised as Runner-up in the Individual Category for his dedicated efforts in rejuvenating traditional water bodies and empowering tribal communities.

In the Organizational Category, the Winners award was conferred upon Aapka Anchal from Bihar for their pioneering efforts in creating sustainable village-level water models.

The Runner-up recognition went to the Association for Development and Research in Socio Economic Activities (ADARSA), Odisha, for its integrated watershed management programs.

The Lifetime Achievement Award was presented to Padmashri Mr. Simon Oraon Minj from Jharkhand, revered as the "Waterman of Jharkhand", for his lifelong dedication to building check dams and ensuring water security across 51 villages.



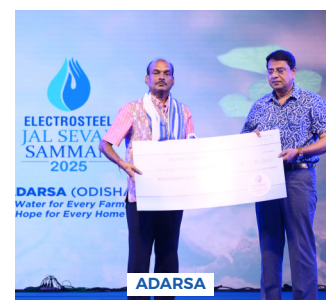

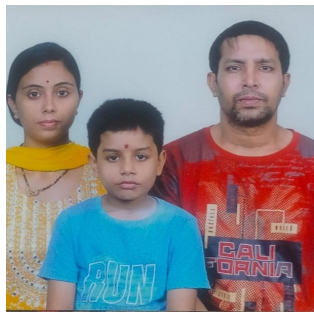
RAKSHA BANDHAN CELEBRATION AT ELECTROSTEEL

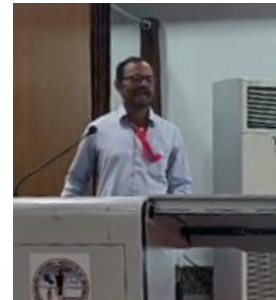
PARICHAY: BRIDGING CONNECTIONS, BUILDING CULTURE

ECL expands to water valves biz

The *Desmarestia* water hyacinth is estimated to be present in 82 Mha of water area in a healthy state. With the completion of the 1990s, the Indian water hyacinth is spreading in the coastal waters of India and also globally. ECL, based in Calcutta and Chennai, is the largest manufacturer, is one of the largest producers of water hyacinth in India with a capacity of 80,000 tonnes. The Indian aquaculture sector is also the largest producer of water hyacinth, suggesting the need for a water hyacinth control strategy.

Swati Kartal, while-time CEO of ECL, says that the company is actively evolving localisation of selected products and services to align with the Make in India initiative and to ensure operations more competitively.

With this acquisition, the company is looking to

of the global private companies in the world. The company provides pipes and fittings and valves for the oil and gas sector under one umbrella. This strengthens our positioning in the oil and gas sector and wastewater infrastructure," says Swati Kartal, CEO of ECL. "Additionally," says Mahesh Kumar, Managing Director, ECL, "The new product line, ECL's T1.5, has a 100% market share in India."

T1.5 has two manufacturing facilities in India, one in Gujarat and one in Karnataka. The key clients come in Italy and Portugal. The company has a turnover of over 600 million. With T1.5, the ECL is, in going to be a global player.

The company is also looking to expand its presence in Africa, awaiting acquisition of a company in the continent of Africa.

Electrosteel expects growth with Bengal's new incentive policy

Kolkata: Electrosteel Castings, a water infrastructure and pipeline solutions provider, is optimistic that state govt's new incentive policy will be industry-friendly. The CM Mamata Banerjee-led govt earlier scrapped the previous policy, prompting some companies to move court.

The Kolkata-based company is also confident that its recent acquisition of Italian valve-maker TIS Service Spa

Sunil Katial, whole-time director and CEO, said the company's proposed ductile iron project in Odisha, with an estimated investment of Rs 3,000 crore, has already been delayed for 8-9 months due to land issue. "We are hoping for a new incentive scheme in Bengal," he said. Electrosteel currently operates three units in Khardah, Bansberia and Haldia.

On the Italian acquisition,

the director and CEO, said the Rs 150 crore deal was funded with internal accruals. TIS, which now earns 40 million Euros annually, has two manufacturing facilities in Italy and Turkey and logistics facilities in Italy and Poland. Agarwal projected a 13-15% turnover growth for TIS over the next few years. "We aim to deepen Electrosteel's presence in Europe, the Middle East, Southeast Asia and Latin America," he added.
