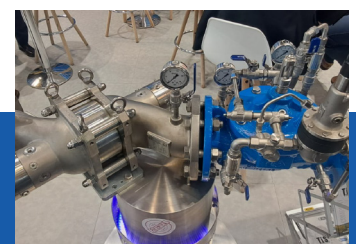
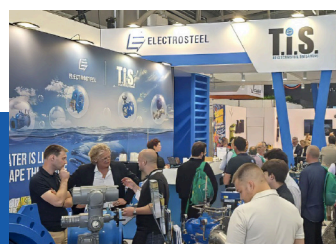
WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY 2026: GROWING A GREENER FUTURE

DRIVING GLOBAL CONVERSATIONS IN ENVIRONMENTAL TECHNOLOGIES

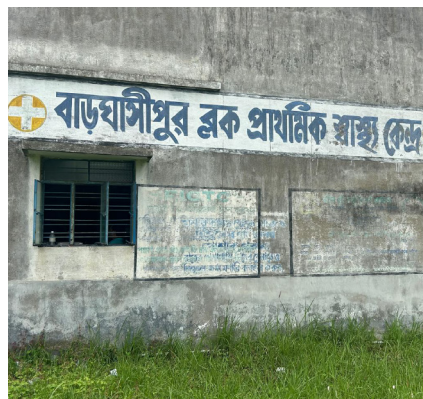

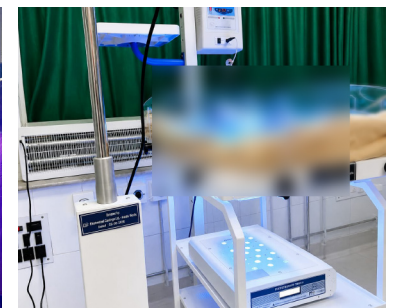


ENABLING CLEAN WATER FOR HEALTHY COMMUNITIES

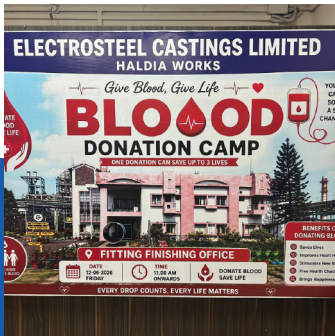
ADVOCATING FOR INCLUSIVE MOBILITY
